It's great to have you worshiping with us today! We hope the information below is helpful. Otherwise, we have no idea what to put on this side.

Children—We offer wonderful **childcare** for infants and children under 5 years of age during the service; stop by the nursery desk to register your child. If you prefer to keep your children with you, we ask that if they are having a hard time remaining quiet, use our **Fellowship Hall**, where your child is free to roam around and explore. It is equipped with a speaker so you can continue to enjoy the service. If you need to change a diaper or are a nursing mom, feel free to use the **Red Room** for privacy. Children 5 years through 2nd grade are encouraged to attend **Children's Church** for a time of interactive learning. They will be dismissed prior to the sermon; watch for the Children's Church slide. Children's activity pages are available at the Welcome Center.

Offering—As our guest, please do not feel obligated to participate in the offering. It is an act of worship and partnership for our regular attenders who consider Bayside their church home. But we **would** love to have you toss your Connection Card into the plate!

Prayer—We consider it a privilege to pray for you! The church staff prays for each request received via the Connection Cards and, if you check the box, your request is also forwarded to our Prayer Chain. If you would like a member of the Prayer Team to pray with you, please indicate that on your Connection Card. We also have Prayer Teams available after each service at the front of the Sanctuary.

Sermons—We include an outline in the bulletin so you can take notes during the sermon. Each color represents a category for easy organizing in your Sermon Notebook: yellow—Knowing; pink—Connecting; green—Living; blue—Telling; other—Special. Free Sermon Notebooks are available at the info table in the Foyer. If you would like to listen to today's message again, hear a message from a week you missed, or share a message with a friend, please visit our website where we have an archive of all our sermons to listen to and/or download. We also have CDs of past sermons available at the Welcome Center.
